This term we will learning about:

- **Mathematics** - Our focus will be on number and place value, capacity, fractions, time, and money.
- **English** - We will concentrate on proper letter formation and crafting simple sentences that include capital letters, full stops, and appropriate finger spaces. Additionally, we will continue to explore generating adjectives and using conjunctions like 'because' and 'and.'
- **Science** - Our studies will involve different materials and their properties.
- **History** - We will explore the contrasts between toys from the past and more modern ones.
- **Religious Education** - Our topic will be 'Christianity,' with an emphasis on Christian beliefs and practices.
- **Phonics** - We are currently focusing on learning sounds from Sets 2 and 3.
